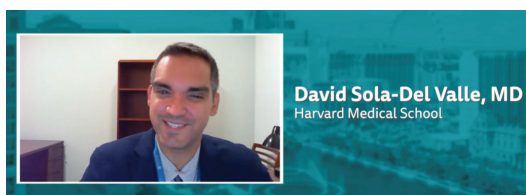

In a recent study of 24 healthy young individuals, a transient and dramatic fluctuation in IOP was observed with resistance training. "This coupled with regular exposure to resistance training is potentially a significant risk factor for glaucoma," the study authors concluded.

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
