Defining Success

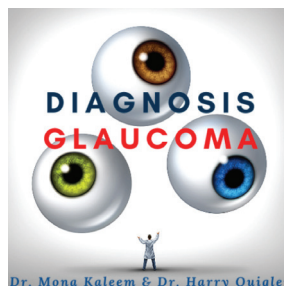
