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Innovations in Ergonomics: Heads-Up Surgery

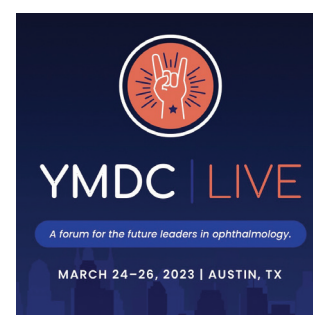
